**Maths:****Planet Maths big book:**

- p.95 This is like the story of ten. The children need to have ten beads on each string. They will complete the number sentence underneath each for the story of 10.
- p. 96 The children have experience with using a number line. The trick is that they have to hop on to the **next** number when adding. For example  $7 + 2 = ?$ . They start with their finger on 7, hop on to 8 and *then* 9. All the footballs that add up to the number 10 should be coloured **blue**, the ones that add to 9 should be **pink/red** and the footballs that add to 7 should be **green**.

- p. 98 Draw circles and colour them. 7, 8, 9, and 10. Encourage your child to count back over them. Sometimes they make mistakes carelessly.

## Gaeilge:

Revise the following vocabulary with your child.

- ag léim – jumping
- ag léamh – reading
- ag scríobh – writing
- ag gáire – laughing
- ag snámh- swimming
- ag rith – running

- ag ól – drinking
- ag ithe - eating

Play a game similar to ‘Simon Says’ with your child.

*‘bí ag leamh’* and check that they are miming reading etc. We are aware that some parents may not know how to pronounce some of these words. If you need more help with this, please send your teacher an email.

## PE

- 10 jump squats every morning and every evening Monday to Friday.
- Try to get out for walks, runs, cycles, playing football. The weather is fantastic at the minute so do enjoy it while we can. As long as your child is moving this is great. Do what you can and do what suits you all.

### **S.E.S.E**

Look out for and discuss the signs of spring: longer days, buds growing, baby lambs being born, days are longer, weather is better. Remind your child that there are three months in spring. They are February, March and April. Talk about the differences between winter and spring. Talk about the differences in the clothes that we wear during each season, the weather, the plants and animals.
