**Cycle Safe Ireland Workshops:** In January pupils from the two Fifth Classes took part in four workshops to promote safety while cycling. This is a new project for St. Ita's and it was positively received by the pupils.

**Internet Safety Workshops:** Helen Butler is an expert in this area and is a regular visitor to the school presenting workshops to 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> classes. These workshops were extended to pupils in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> classes at the end of January and the pupils received advice and knowledge as to how to keep safe while on the internet. ## **Literacy and Numeracy:**

- Literacy Stations and team teaching by three teachers in Mr. Whelan's Senior Infant Class is in operation one day per week during second term.
- The Reading Recovery Intervention Programme co-ordinated by Ms. Murray is continuing during this term.
- Lift off to Literacy Power Hour team teaching by three teachers over six to eight weeks in Ms. O'Brien's Third Class.
- Olive Mooney visiting author, Olive visited pupils in 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> classes in mid-January. She read from her books and discussed and advised pupils on creative writing.
- Write A Book Project pupils in 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> classes took part in this creative writing project. Entries have now been submitted to Galway Education Centre.
- Visits to the local Library a number of classes have visited the Library at the start of this term.
- New equipment (mini whiteboards, cuisenaire rods) has been purchased for all classes.
- New sets of classroom novels have been purchased for  $4^{\text{th}}$ ,  $5^{\text{th}} \& 6^{\text{th}}$  classes.
- Sets of HiLo Readers (Folens) have been purchased for the Support Teaching Classrooms.

<u>Catholic Schools Week:</u> This was held from  $23^{rd} - 27^{th}$  January. The school Mass took place on Thursday  $26^{th}$  January.

<u>**Credit Union Quiz:**</u> 8 teams of 4 pupils from  $5^{th}$  &  $6^{th}$  classes took part in the Quiz on Saturday evening  $28^{th}$  January. It was an educational and enjoyable experience. Well done to the pupils who represented the school in this event.

**<u>Visits to Infant Classes:</u>** Joe Higgins, a Postman visited the Junior and Senior Infant classes on Tuesday, 7<sup>th</sup> February.
